

TOWN LOOP



Directions to the run:

From center of Leesburg, North on King St.

Left on North St, follow street to right, (the start of Old Waterford Rd),

Park at Rust Library which is approximately ½ mile on right (380 Old Waterford Rd.).

Description of run:

Take a quick running tour of central Leesburg. Starting at Rust Library this run goes through historic downtown, along the W&OD Trail, up Plaza Street, meandering through residential trails to Battlefield Parkway, alongside of Ida Lee Park, ending back at Rust Library.

Hill Rating: 1 (mostly flat)

Surface: P (all pavement)

Route: 5.20 miles

Starting at the Rust Library, exit left onto Old Waterford Road and follow to North Street.

Make a left onto North Street and follow to King Street.

Make a right onto King Street and follow to the W & OD Trail.

Make a left onto the W&OD Trail and follow it to W & OD mile marker 33.5 at Plaza Street.

Make a left onto Plaza Street and follow it to North Street.

Make a right onto North Street and follow it to Cherry Lane.

Make a left onto Cherry Lane and follow it to its dead end. Continue on the sidewalk and across the streets and speed bumps into apartment complex where you can get on the community trail. Follow the trail around the pond and between tennis courts to Plaza Street.

Make a right onto Plaza Street and follow it to Battlefield Parkway.

Make a left onto asphalt path running along Battlefield Parkway and follow to King Street,

Make a left at King Street and remain on the asphalt trail until the intersection with Oakcrest Manor Drive.

Make a right across King Street and follow the asphalt path parallel with Ida Lee Drive back to the start at rust Library.
